MOTION: moved by Loretta, seconded by Rosa to allow the nomination of Joanna Cataldo to CSC in the role of Co-Secretary. **CARRIED** Principals/VP's School/Graduation Pictures - BrightPics has been booked for Mr. Torres/ Report/Teacher's November 1st and November 19th (retake day). Grad photo dates are Ms. Sodhi Report pending. Staffing/Enrollment - 52 students registered for online learning. this resulted in the collapse of a grade 34 class and the reduction of 1 planning time teacher. Currently 543 students are registered for in class learning. Technology - All grades 7 & 8 students will receive an Edwin laptop courtesy of the board. All online students requiring technology have been given one from the school. Remaining devices will remain in the school for in class learners. Currently there are 131 chromebooks, and of the 50 chromebooks that were harvested to students outside of our school have been returned to St. Cornelius. It was highlighted that some of these devices have been deemed unusable. 125 new chromebooks were purchased in 2021 by Ms. Maas, in addition to 40 new ipads. In total St. Cornelius has 291 chromebooks. In total St. Cornelius has 113 ipads to be used by FDK - grade 3 students. To date all classes will be equipped with dedicated for each class. Smartboards have also been upgraded. School Trips – due to covid no school trips will be offered to students at this time. This decision is guided by Peel Public Health. School Day Routine - when climate is a factor, students will not be permitted to use the fields, they will be assigned to the paved areas for recess. Markings are on the pavement to continue cohort requirements. Library is open for students to use. Gym class will resume this term. Sanitation stations are in the gym for students to use before and after class. Health & Safety - masks and PPE equipment has been provided by the Board for all faculty. No visitors are permitted into the school. Masks are mandated in school by all students and staff. The new school logo was presented to CSC and will be used moving forward. A new ventilation system - central air cooling will be installed in the older section of the school. A new security system and doorbell will be updated. Wifi system has been upgraded.
